## **Pollinator Plant Guide**

## <u>Perennials</u>



Canada goldenrod - Solidago canadensisHeight: 2-5 feet.Seed is non-dormant, and can be planted in the fall or spring.



### Douglas aster - Symphyotrichum subspicatum

Height: 1-4 feet. Spreads by rhizomes.

Fall is the preferred time for sowing because the seeds need a period of cold stratification to break dormancy, which occurs naturally during the winter months.



# Cascades Penstemon - Penstemon serrulatus

Height: 1.5-2 feet Needs cold moist stratification, sow in fall.



Yarrow - Achillea millefoliumHeight: 1.5-2 feetNeeds cold moist stratification, sow in fall. Just cover seeds lightly.



#### Pearly everlasting - Anaphalis margaritacea

Height: 2 feet. Needs ~30 days cold moist stratification, sow in fall or early spring. Seed needs light to germinate, do not cover after planting.



Western columbine - Aquilegia Formosa Height: 2 feet.

Needs cold moist stratification, sow in fall. Seed needs light to germinate, do not cover after planting.



Nodding onion – Allium cernuum Height: 2 feet. Needs cold moist stratification, sow in fall.



Hairy honeysuckle – Lonicera hispidula Trailing or climbing vine. Needs cold moist stratification, sow in fall.



Common Cow-parsnip - Heracleum maximum Height: 2--5 feet. 72 hour water soak; cold moist stratification, sow in fall



Graceful Cinquefoil - Potentilla gracilis

Height: 1.5-2 feet

Cold moist stratification, sow in fall.



Henderson's Checker Mallow - Sidalcea hendersonii
Height: 3 feet.
Best germination if scarify seeds, rub on sandpaper.
Needs cold moist stratification, sow in fall.



Riverbank lupine - *Lupinus rivularis* (this photo) Bigleaf lupine - *Lupinus polyphyllus* Height: 3-6 feet. Scarify seeds, rub on sandpaper. Sow spring or fall.



Puget gumweed - Grindelia integrifolia

Height: 3-4 feet.

Germinates at 65 degrees, keep moist. Can be kept cooler after germination. I have been starting indoors in March.



Showy fleabane - Erigeron speciosus

Height: 2 feet.

Germinates at 65 degrees, keep moist. Can be kept cooler after germination. I have been starting indoors in March.

### <u>Annuals</u>

Sow spring or fall. No cold stratification needed. Will self-seed.



Farewell to spring - Clarkia amoena

Height: ~ 2 foot



**Blue gilia** - *Gilia capitata* Height: 2-3 foot



Large-Flowered Collomia - Collomia grandiflora

Height: ~ 2 foot Self-seeds a lot



Rocky Mountain beeplant - Peritoma serrulata

Height: 3 -6 foot



**Douglas Meadow foam** - *Limnanthes douglasii* Height: ~ 1 foot Self-seeds a lot. Native to northern California
